Parent Code of Conduct

Parents are vital in helping their children maintain high moral character, fulfill their commitment and keep a positive attitude. Storm All Stars wants to serve as a partner to the parents--helping each child achieve these goals--but the primary job must lie with the parents. Please read this carefully and understand that you are making a commitment of time and financial resources. You are also committing to support our program's philosophies and goals. By signing below, you understand & accept the Parent Code of Conduct.

1. I understand that my actions are a reflection of Storm All Stars and should be of strong moral character. I will be a positive role model for my child and will encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for ALL athletes, coaches, and spectators at every practice and competition. If the viewing area becomes a negative environment at any time during the year, those directly involved in the negativity will be asked to drop off their children for practice and return for a timely pickup.
2. I am aware that the team season & commitment is June 2021 thru May 2022. I will do everything in my ability to enable my child to participate in all practices and competitions throughout the entire season, including end of the season bid events which may be out of state. I understand that a team is depending on my child to fulfill his/her responsibilities as a team member. I will do all that is necessary to get my child to practice & competitions on time and assure that he/she does not need to leave practices early.
3. I will maintain a positive attitude by remembering that children participate in cheerleading to have fun, and that the sport is for children, not adults.
4. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will not feel defeated by the outcome of a competition or his/her performance. I will encourage my child to be a humble winner and a gracious loser.
5. I will respect the coaches and their authority during practices and competitions and will not question, discuss, or confront the coaches during a practice or a competition, nor will I pull my child out of practice without communicating with the coach. I will take the time to speak with the coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
6. If my child is involved in any matter of disrespect towards any Storm All Stars staff member or student, I will resolve this problem with my child immediately.
7. I fully understand that the coaches reserve the right to suspend my child's participation indefinitely in practice or competition (which may include losing positions) as a disciplinary action if any of the rules, policies, or codes of conduct are not adhered to.
8. I will attend parent meetings, read e-mails, and check the website to retrieve information that Storm All Stars has prepared.

Attendance Guidelines & Expectations

1. **Practices are Mandatory:** The success of our teams depend on each individual's commitment to the program. In order to build a strong team, we must have a strong dedication to the program. Practices are mandatory for all team members. Extra practices may be scheduled in the weeks leading up to competition if necessary. We do occasionally make modifications to the team schedules throughout the year.
2. **Absence Request:** We require **7-day advance written notice via email to BillieOdem@Me.com** if an athlete will miss practice for any reason. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused absence. In the case of illness or emergency, coaches need to be contacted via text / email immediately. Injured athletes are required to attend practices unless their physician has directed otherwise. If you do not contact anyone regarding an absence, it will be considered unexcused. ****It is the responsibility of the athlete to learn any changes they missed due to an absence, which may include extra practice time and / or booking private lessons with the team coach.**
3. **Tardy Notification:** If you're going to be late for any reason, you must call or text All Star Director, Billie Odem a minimum of 30 minutes before practice begins. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused tardy. If you do not contact anyone regarding tardy arrival, it will be considered unexcused. Athletes are expected to arrive 15 minutes in advance of scheduled practice start time.
4. **Competition Practices:** Athletes CANNOT miss any practices two weeks prior to competition. Excessive absences before competition may result in the athletes being replaced in the routine at the discretion of the coach.
5. **Competition Attendance:** All competitions are MANDATORY. Please don't make any additional plans for the weekends of a competition. There are no excused absences from a competition.
6. **3 Strike Policy**
 - 3 unexcused absences = \$25 fee
 - Every unexcused absence thereafter will result in a \$25 fee
 - 3 unexcused tardy arrivals = \$25 fee
 - Every unexcused tardy arrival thereafter will result in a \$25 fee
7. **Excused Absence**
 - Mandatory school functions that result in a grade
 - Death in the immediate family
 - Contagious illnesses (vomiting, fever, strep throat, etc.)
 - Hospitalization (a doctor's note will need to be submitted to the head coach)
8. **Unexcused Absences such as, but not limited to:** Vacations, Dances, concerts, part-time jobs, homework / studying, birthdays, school/church socials, and other non-related school activities

For excessive absences and / or tardy arrivals, the athlete may subject themselves to dismissal from the team.

Financial Guidelines

1. I acknowledge that, under the terms of this Agreement, my athlete(s) will be charged a registration fee once a year and all team & class tuition will be payable on the 1st day of each month. If fees are not paid on time, I acknowledge that late fees will be charged & assessed.
2. I understand that the team tuition portion of the monthly fees covers training & related expenses. Tuition will not be prorated for holidays, gym closings, and weeks without practices. Competition fees will be billed separately.
3. I understand that all candidates must show a \$0 balance on their Storm All Stars account from any previous commitments to be eligible for a team for the season. Please direct any concerns to Marisa Perry.
4. I understand that the first team payment is due June 1st, 2020. Your athlete will not be allowed to participate until this is paid. All payments are made payable to Storm All Stars. Every month thereafter, tuition is due by the 1st of the month. Late fees will be assessed to outstanding accounts.
5. I understand that carrying a balance on my account will hinder my athlete from taking additional classes or private lessons until team tuition has been paid. In addition, if monthly tuition is not paid by the 1st of each month, my athlete will be sat out of practice until the account is current.
6. I understand that if my athlete that does not have the required skills for their level, they will be required to take a tumbling and / or jumps. Team members will receive a \$25 discount for classes. Tuition will not be pro-rated for missed practices due to vacations, holidays, competitions, gym closings, sickness or injuries.
7. I understand that if any installment is late or missed, Storm All Stars reserves the right to continue with the collections process and take whatever action is deemed necessary to recover the full amount of the debt including but not limited to cancellation of this agreement and/or exclusion of your child from participation in all Storm All Stars related activities.
8. Should your athlete be removed from the program for either disciplinary reasons or by your choice, there are **NO REFUNDS** for any reason. A fee of \$350 will be processed & due immediately to any athlete who leaves the program voluntarily, or for disciplinary reasons.
